

1-WEEK PROGRAM:

BUSINESS, FINANCE, AND MANAGEMENT

Our top level 1-Week Program in Business, Finance and Management takes place in the heart of New York City's iconic Midtown Manhattan.

Our 1-Week Program is offered all year round.

Each 1-Week program is the length of one week, with courses and company visits all included.

The program is comprised of 3 hours of class per day, with the rest of the time devoted to case studies, company visits, and free time to explore the city.

There are 4 academic quarters per year: Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer. You can choose to register for the 1-Week program during whichever quarter works best for you.

Do I get credits for attending the program?

As a licensed institution, we offer credits, but it is ultimately the respective universities' decision to accept them.

How much time must I commit to the program each week?

You will have to commit to 12 hours of classes per week, plus an additional 3-4 hours for independent work. Company visits are also scheduled throughout the week, and last an average duration of 1.5-2 hours.

Will I be able to find housing accommodations in New York?


